CHAPTER I

Explanatory note

The publication, "Notice to mariners" is published monthly and contains information on safety of navigation in the Black Sea and Sea of Marmara, and the radio navigational warnings transmitted by NAVAREA III Coordinator.

The present "Notice to mariners" publication contains information from internal and external partners of the Hydrographic Maritime Directorate „Comandor Alexandru Cătuneanu” up until **19.07.2026**.

General

Object position is given by geographical coordinates or by bearing and distance from a landmark on the chart; longitudes are reported to Greenwich meridian.

Geographical positions are given for the largest scale chart in the region and in accordance with the chart datum of that chart.

Courses and bearings are True, are rated from 0° to 360°, alignments directions are given from the sea to the land and sectors of the lights are visible from the sea to the land.

The distance of light visibility is given in nautical miles.

Depths and heights are given in meters above mean sea level.

Numbering Notices

Notice numbering is consecutive throughout a calendar year. Information from the Romanian seaside is numbered and continuing clockwise.

The number of a notice consists publication number and serial number of that notice, separated by a slash.

Original information is given in English languages. The number of information is preceded by a star (*).

CHAPTER II contains in section 2.1. nautical publication tables which will be corrected by the notices of this publication.

Geographic index from 2.2. section presents the title and the numbers of notices on geographical areas.

Paragraph 2.3.1. has informative notices. Notices are without correction charts and do not affect other nautical publications.

The content of permanent, preliminary and temporary notices can be found in section 2.4. The permanent notices make final correction to marine charts. Temporary and preliminary notices are not final. Insert point (P) or (T) after the serial number of a notice shows his preliminary or temporary character.

Quarterly, in paragraph 2.5. are given, "Summary list of temporary/preliminary notices in force" and "Summary list of corrected charts" for the current year.

CHAPTER III contains the radio navigational warnings transmitted by NAVAREA III Coordinator.

CHAPTER IV includes corrections for updating the nautical publications.

CHAPTER V contains information about editing, reprinting or disposal of nautical charts and publications.

The Notices to Mariners (NM) edited by Maritime Directorate Hydrographic "Comandor Alexandru Cătuneanu" through the Notices to Mariners Laboratory (AWNIS) are available on the MDH web page at the address:

https://www.dhmf.n.ro/ro/cautare_an.html, in romanian and english and users can access the updated nautical charts starting with the year 2020 by scanning a QR code.

Recommendation

Due to the danger to navigation that can be caused by the possible presence of sea mines in the area of maritime responsibility of Romania we advise all sailing ships approaching and leaving Romanian harbours to use position 43°47,59' N, 028° 50,86' E and as the case may be, to follow recommended tracks:

1 (43°47.59' N, 028°50.86' E; 43°47.59' N, 028°37.61' E)

2 (43°47,59' N, 028°50,86' E; 44°11,33' N, 028°50,86' E; 44°15,52' N, 028°45,04' E)

- position 43°58,79' N, 028°50,86' E (recommended track 2) used for entry to traffic separation scheme Constanta);

- ships exit/leaving the traffic separation scheme Constanta in position 43°56,75' N, 028°50,86' E (recommended track 2).

INSTRUCTIONS

HYDROGRAPHIC NOTE

Mariners are requested to notify the Romanian Maritime Hydrographic Directorate „Comandor Alexandru Cătuneanu” (by telephone, fax or by e-mail) when new or suspected dangers to navigation are discovered, changes observed in aids to navigation, or corrections to publications are seen to be necessary. Mariners can also report any ENC display issues experienced. This form and its instructions have been designed to help both the sender and the recipient. It should be used, or followed closely, whenever appropriate.

The Hydrographic Note H.102 is the preferred method for submission of information relating to charts and publications.

Accurate position or knowledge of positional error is of great importance. Latitude and longitude should only be used to specifically position the details when they have been fixed by GPS or Astronomical Observations. A full description of the method, equipment, time, estimated error and datum (where applicable) used should be given. When position is defined by sextant angles or bearings (true or magnetic to be specified), more than two should be used in order to provide a redundancy check. Where position is derived from Electronic Position Fixing (e.g. LORAN C) or distances observed by radar, the raw readings of the system in use should be quoted wherever possible. Where position is derived after the event, from other observations and/or Dead Reckoning, the methodology of deriving the position should be included.

Paper Charts

A cutting from the largest scale chart is the best medium for forwarding details, the alterations and additions being shown thereon in red. When requested, a new copy will be sent in replacement of a chart that has been used to forward information, or when extensive observations have involved defacement of the observer's chart. If it is preferred to show the amendments on a tracing of the largest scale chart (rather than on the chart itself) these should be in red as above, but adequate details from the chart must be traced in black ink to enable the amendments to be fitted correctly.

The Hydrographic Note H.102A is the preferred method for submission of information relating to ports and harbours and should be accompanied by a **Form H.102**.

The form has been designed for use as an aide-memoir as well as providing the necessary information required for Sailing Directions.

Reports which cannot be confirmed or are lacking in detail should not be withheld. Notations should be made indicating any shortcomings and any firm expectations of when the information may be confirmed.
